Klüh Security receives the Comenius Award for the eighth time in a row

Award-winning digital educational media have to be designed and implemented according to pedagogical, didactic, aesthetic and technical criteria. This year, approximately 200 manufacturers, publishers, projects and authors from eight European countries submitted digital educational products for a manufacturer-neutral quality check.

The Comenius EduMedia Award originated with the educator Johann Amos Comenius (1592-1670). Comenius was a pioneer of a popular and child-oriented education, and he propagated the systematic use of pictures and vividness for didactic purposes.
